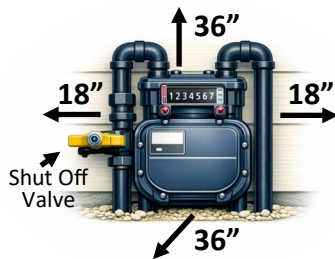

Required Gas Meter Clearance

Keep Area Clear



Maintaining proper clearance around your gas meter is essential for safety and accessibility.

Keep **36 inches of clear space above and in front of the meter**, and **18 inches clear on both sides** at all times. This open space allows gas company personnel to safely read, inspect, or service the meter and ensures quick access for emergency responders if the gas needs to be shut off.

Obstructions such as shrubs, fencing, decorations, or stored items can slow response time during an emergency and create unsafe conditions.

Always keep the meter area—especially the shut-off valve—clear and easily accessible.

Know what's below!



Before starting any digging or landscaping project, it's essential to call MISS DIG at **811** to have underground utilities safely marked.

Whether you're installing a fence, planting shrubs, or doing larger excavation work, contacting 811 at least **three business days in advance** helps prevent damage to natural gas lines, electric cables, water pipes, and communication lines.

Striking an underground utility can cause serious injuries, service outages, costly repairs, and even life-threatening situations.
